

PROGRAM SUMMARY

- **Credit Hours:** 120
- **Concentrations:** (1) Performance, Choreography & Theory, and (2) Dance Education (see pp. 4-5 of this document)
- **Declaring the Major:** For the BA in Dance, students declare their major upon admission to the university. A placement audition, held the spring previous to commencing study, is required before registering for technique classes.
- **Advising (For the Major):** Incoming and assigned majors are advised by the Performing Arts Academic Advisor, Hannah Harrell (hbharrel@uncc.edu), in consultation with Dance Director of Undergraduate Study, Delia Neil (dlnail@uncc.edu) and faculty.
- **Advising (For General Education):** Performing Arts Academic Advisor, Hannah Harrell, also advises General Education courses.
- **Minimum Grades/GPA:** To meet requirements for the Concentration in Performance, Choreography, and Theory, students must attain a minimum of 2.75 GPA in all Dance courses; a minimum 2.5 GPA overall; and have no more than one “D” in any Dance course. In addition, students are required to complete a formal review in their third semester for continued status as a Dance Major.
- **Teacher Licensure:** Yes, see BA in Dance with a Concentration in Dance Education (pp. 4-5).
- **Evening Classes Available:** Yes, but the program cannot be completed by a night student.
- **Weekend Classes Available:** No

PROGRAM SUMMARY

- **Credit Hours:** 120-128
- **Concentrations:** Dance Education
- **Declaring the Major:** Students attend a required placement audition in the Spring prior to expected Fall enrollment. Once admitted, students begin by declaring a major in Dance and completing recommended coursework for the Dance Education concentration in the first three semesters. Approximately third semester, students apply to Teacher Education which requires a cumulative GPA of 2.7 or higher, a 2.75 or better in all Dance coursework, C or better in both EDUC 2100 and SPED 2100, a clear criminal background check, signed Professional Dispositions statement and passing scores on Praxis Core (or proven exemption via test scores).
- **Advising (For the Major):** Incoming and assigned majors are advised by Tesh Ramey, Arts Education Specialist (hramey@uncc.edu).
- **Advising (For General Education):** Tesh Ramey, Arts Education Specialist
- **Minimum Grades/GPA:** Students must maintain a cumulative GPA of at least 2.5 to remain in the program, earn no more than one "D" in any major course, and maintain a 2.75 GPA in all courses required for the major. A cumulative GPA of at least 2.75 is required to apply for student teaching senior year.
- **Teacher Licensure:** Yes, via completion of all Dance Education program requirements and a B or better in Student Teaching.
- **Evening Classes Available:** Yes, but the program cannot be completed by a night student
- **Weekend Classes Available:** No

PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

The Dance Education concentration *has a rigorous and fixed curriculum*. Interested students should declare their intent to pursue the concentration and meet the Arts Education Specialist as soon as possible. After completion of foundation courses and being accepted to Teacher Education, students progress with upper level coursework in the College of Arts + Architecture and Cato College of Education and the Dance Education concentration is added to their transcript. Failure to complete the Application to Teacher Education by sophomore year results in a delayed graduation date.
