PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

The BA degree in JAPANESE STUDIES is a *relatively structured program*, beginning with language classes at the beginning and intermediate levels and culminating in more advanced classes in literature and culture as well as continued study of the language itself. The major encourages students to master the language through study abroad opportunities. Students with little or no background in the language should declare the major as Freshmen in order to graduate on time; students who do not need to take beginning or intermediate language classes may declare as late as their junior year and still complete the degree on schedule. Students interested in study abroad should contact the Department *as early as possible*. A double Major is highly recommended.

Areas	Credit Hours	Description
Pre-Major/ Prerequisites	0-20	Hours vary depending on student's language background. Students may place themselves based on the number of years the language was studied in high school. These students are required to have an interview prior to the semester starts in order to start learning Japanese in the appropriate level at UNC Charlotte. Some students may not need any classes at these levels.
Major	27-35	Hours vary depending on the language.
General Education (not satisfied by other major requirements)	40-41	Courses are offered in each language that satisfy the O goal. Writing intensive courses for the major are offered in English and may be satisfied by any W course offered with a departmental rubric. W classes may or may not count toward the major depending on the language.
Related Work (Senior Seminar)	1	Survey of career options for foreign language majors, directed professional development (preparation of resume and portfolio), and completion of departmental required assessments in the areas of speaking, reading, writing, grammar, and content knowledge of the major.
