PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

The Department of Music offers a B.A. degree in Music, a *somewhat structured* program. All majors must take at least 26 hours in Musicianship Courses, which include music theory, ear training, piano, and music history, as well as 26-30 hours in Performance Courses, which include private lessons and ensembles. B.A. in Music majors must also take 26 hours of electives *outside of music*.

NOTES

1. Each course in the Core Music Curriculum as well as all other required courses in music and music performance must be passed with a grade of "C" or better to progress through the curriculum.
2. All music majors must enroll in Applied Music, a Primary Ensemble, and Performance Class every fall or spring semester they are enrolled in school.
3. Piano/Organ majors must take four semesters of MUSC 2150 (Accompanying) instead of four semesters of Class Piano.
4. In addition to the courses in the Major Courses, Bachelor of Arts in Music students must complete at least 26 hours outside of music (accounted for in the APS), and may take additional electives to reach 120 credit hours for the degree.
5. All music majors must successfully complete the Sophomore Review before enrolling in any MUPF or MUSC courses at the 3000 or 4000 level. See the *Student Handbook* for the requirements of the Sophomore Review process.
6. All music majors entering Fall 2013 and later are required to enroll in at least two Secondary Ensembles prior to graduation. See the *Student Handbook* for approved Secondary Ensembles.
