

PROGRAM SUMMARY

- **Credit Hours:** 120 hours
- **Concentrations:** Applied Anthropology (optional)
- **Declaring the Major:** Minimum GPA of 2.0 preferred; students with GPA below 2.0 should consult with departmental advisor; no pre-requisite courses; change of major form accepted year-round except during pre-registration periods; orientation/advising session required after declaration.
- **Advising (For the Major):** Required on admission to the major; required during pre-registration for all students with GPA below 2.2; recommended at least once per year.
- **Advising (For General Education):** by Anthropology department advisors or by advisors in CLAS Advising Center.
- **Minimum Grades/GPA:** GPA of 2.0 in the major required for graduation; C or better in ANTH 3601 and 4601.
- **Teacher Licensure:** No specific licensure program in Anthropology, there is licensure in social studies.
- **Evening Classes Available:** YES; electives can be completed at night, but all core courses are not available at night so, the major cannot be completed at night.
- **Weekend Classes Available:** No
- **Other Information:** Internships, Field Courses, Departmental Honors, Lambda Alpha National Honor Society

PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

There are two variations of the Anthropology major: (a) General Anthropology and (b) Anthropology with a concentration in Applied Anthropology. The General Anthropology major has a *moderately flexible* curriculum. The major with concentration in Applied Anthropology is *more structured*. Both versions require 11 courses, with the same 5 core courses. Ideally, students will take a progression of courses beginning with ANTH 1101, the foundation course. Both variations of the major culminate with ANTH 4601, the senior seminar, which should be taken right before graduation. However, students have flexibility in designing their own program of study *in consultation with an advisor*, so students declaring as sophomores and even early in their junior year can usually finish their degree on schedule.

Transfer students with an associate's degree are exempt from most General Education, but must complete Writing Intensive requirement in the major and the Foreign Language requirement.

Foreign Language	0-11	Must demonstrate competence at the level of the first semester of 2000-level in a language in the Roman alphabet; or, must demonstrate competence at the 1202 level in a language in a non-Roman alphabet; competence can be demonstrated by transfer courses, placement exam, or courses at UNC Charlotte. Additional foreign language is recommended, but not required.
