

## PROGRAM SUMMARY

- **Credit Hours:** 120 hours
- **Concentrations:** No
- **Declaring the Major:** All students must have a cumulative GPA of 2.5 and meet with the departmental Academic Advisor before declaring the Art History major.
- **Advising (For the Major):** Advising is required of all majors before each registration period with Departmental Academic Advisor. Faculty members act as career mentors.
- **Advising (For General Education):** Students use CAPP online to monitor completion of general education requirements and meet with Departmental Academic Advisor. All students must demonstrate Foreign Language proficiency through the 1202 level.
- **Minimum Grades/GPA:** Cumulative 2.5 GPA required for entrance into BA in Art History. Department only recognizes C or above in all classes counting towards major.

Students who demonstrate proficiency through testing must still complete 8 course credits of elective coursework to meet total credit hour requirement of 120 hours for graduation.
